'The Langdales'

A three-day workshop based at the Three Shires Inn in the beautiful little Langdale Valley.

The workshop will involve travelling to predominately Skelwith Bridge and taking in the fantastic painting and drawing opportunities around Elterwater with its breathtaking views of the Langdales.

'Eskdale'

A three-day workshop based at the Eskdale Gate

The stunning location of Wastwater (Britain's favourite view) is only a 15 minute drive away and could be visited if the group would like to travel in their own cars.

'Bardsea'

A two-day weekend workshop based at the

'Coniston'

A two-day weekend workshop based at the Waterhead Hotel in a beautiful location at the northern edge of Lake Coniston.

Our featured location - 'Yew Tree Farm'

The two day 'Coniston' weekend workshop based at the Waterhead Hotel allows us to not only visit the wonderful location of Tarn Hows but also to visit 'Yew Tree Farm' which is a very short drive from the hotel.

When the producers of the recent 'Miss Potter' film starring Rene Zellweger as Beatrix Potter decided her house at 'Hill Top' in Near Sawrey would be unsuitable for filming they decided to use one of her other former properties just outside of Coniston called 'Yew Tree Farm'.

Yew Tree is a working farm of 600 acres set in one of the most picturesque parts of the Lake District.

Originally built in 1693

the farmhouse was owned in the 1930's by Beatrix Potter or Mrs Heelis as she was known locally and is still home to many of her original furnishings.

The present owners of Yew Tree farm are kindly allowing 'Lakeland Arts' to use the grounds of the farm for one of

our 'Coniston' painting and drawing days, in turn we will be customers for the day to the excellent tea room....
